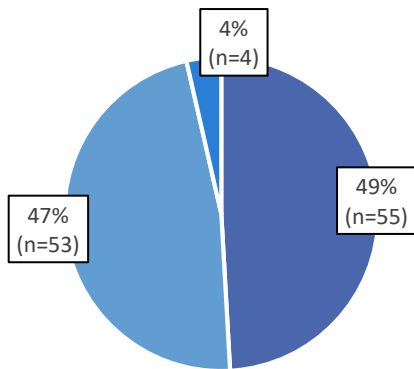


Firearm Suicide in Delaware

- Nearly half of all gun deaths in Delaware are suicides.
- The majority of suicides (45%) in Delaware are by firearm.
- The firearm suicide rate in Delaware has been consistently lower than the national rate over the last decade (2006-2015).
- 76% of people who die by firearm suicide in Delaware are male; and 85% are White.

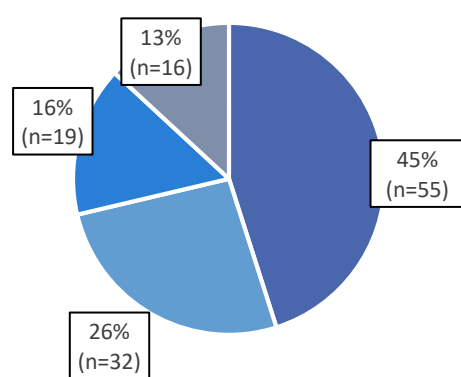
Gun Deaths in Delaware, 2015

Total Gun Deaths in 2015: 112

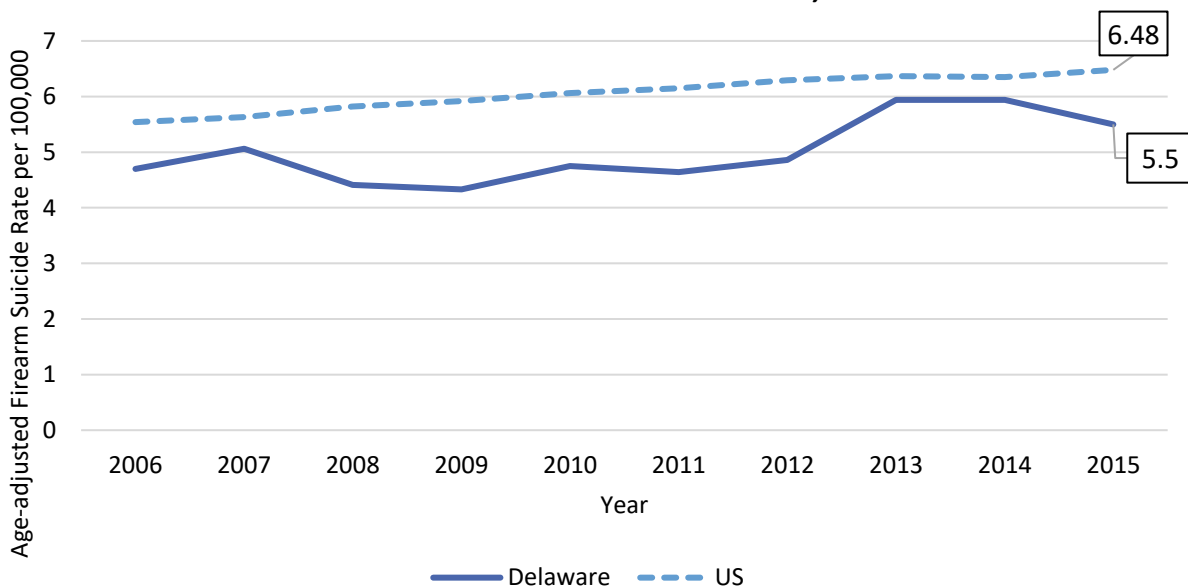
Suicide Deaths in Delaware, 2015



■ Firearm ■ Suffocation ■ Poisoning ■ Other

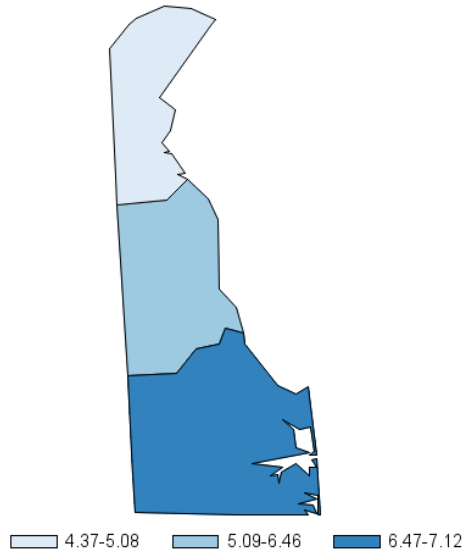

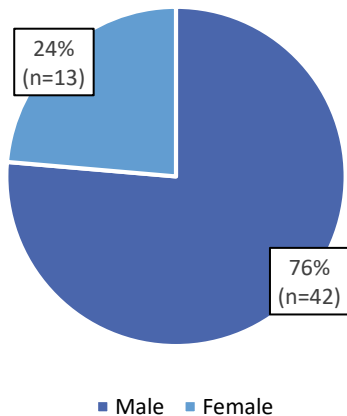

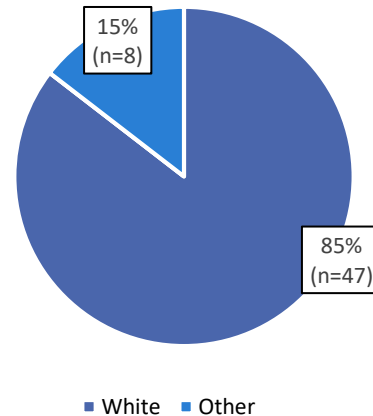
