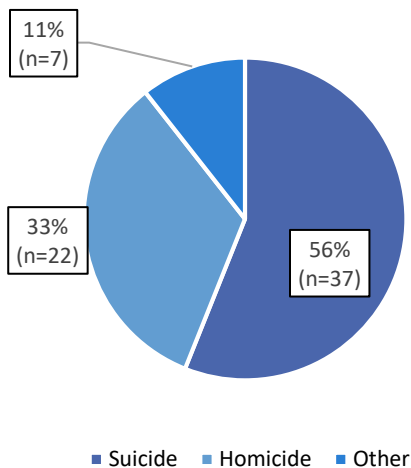


Firearm Suicide in Hawaii

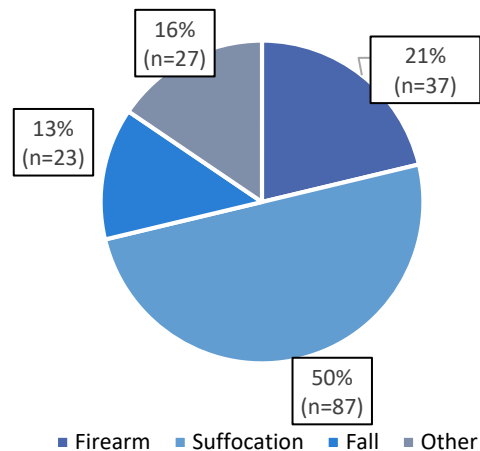
- More than half of all gun deaths (56%) in Hawaii are suicides.
- Firearm is the most lethal mean of suicide and 21% of all suicides are by firearm in Hawaii.
- 86% of people who die by firearm suicide in Hawaii are male; and 57% are Asian/Pacific Islander.

Gun Deaths in Hawaii, 2016



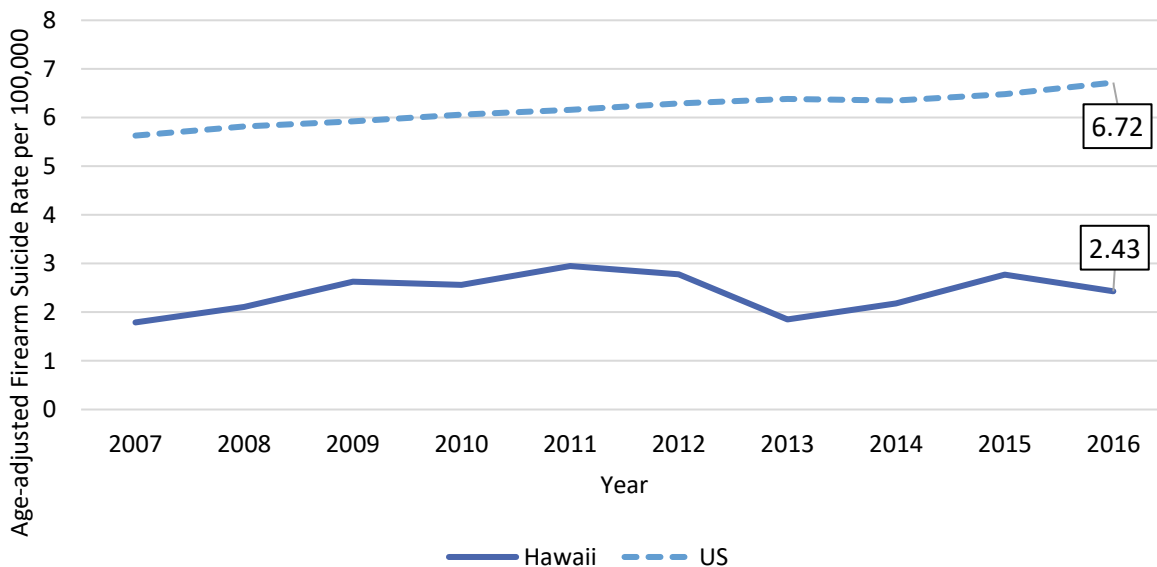
Total Gun Deaths in 2016: 66

Suicide Deaths in Hawaii, 2016

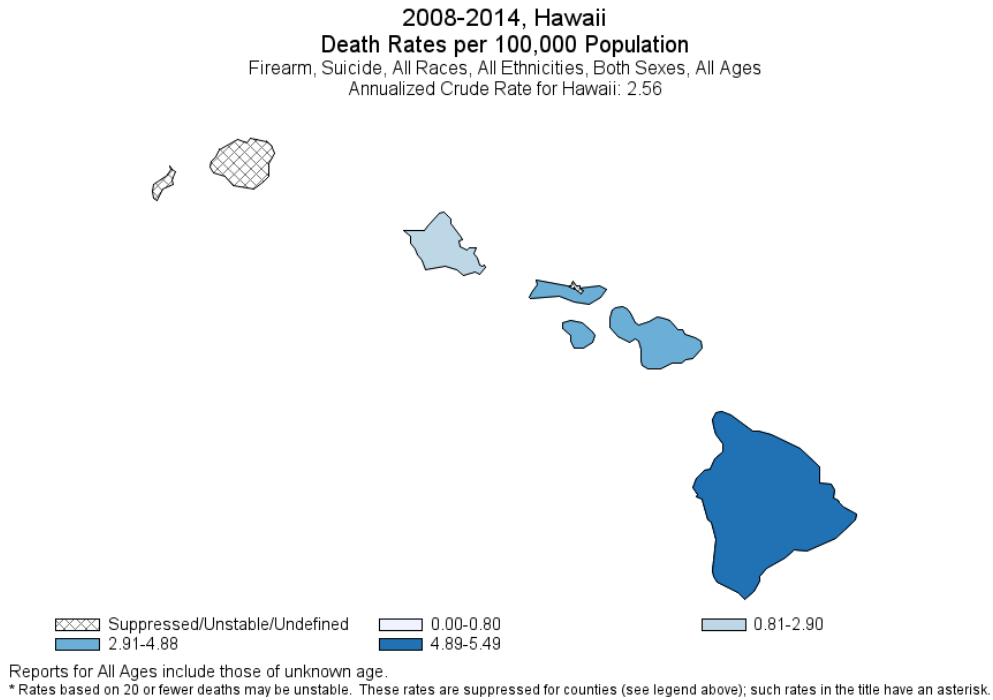


Total Suicide Deaths in 2016: 174

Firearm Suicide Rate over the last decade, 2007-2016

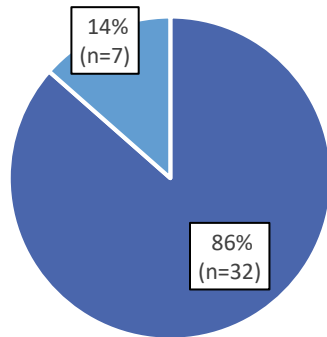


Firearm Suicide in Hawaii – Demographic Information



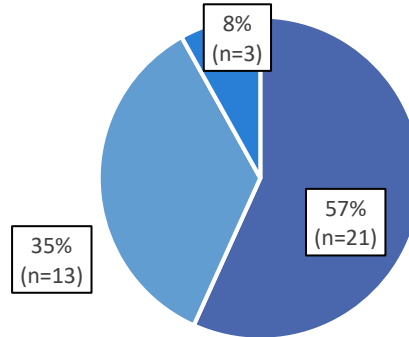
