


FIREARM SUICIDE RATES IN PENNSYLVANIA

VARIATIONS ACROSS THE STATE

On average, two people die by firearm suicide every single day in Pennsylvania. Pennsylvania's average firearm suicide rate is <u>higher</u> than the national firearm suicide rate (7.11 per 100,000 population versus 6.79, respectively). However, the firearm suicide rate varies greatly across the state. Philadelphia County has the lowest firearm suicide death rate in Pennsylvania (3.8 deaths per 100,000 population) and Wayne County has the highest (16.74 deaths per 100,000 population).
