Responsibilities and Duties

- Research skills, including ability to conduct thorough literature reviews and synthesize information on topics such as public health, criminology, public policy, and criminal justice reform

- Independent, able to work with little direction when needed while also a good team player and collaborative worker
- Minimum education: bachelor's degree in public health, sociology, or related field. Master's in public health preferred.
